Business Interruption Loan

Loans from the British Business Bank will be available at british-business-bank.co.uk

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Job Retention Scheme

Government grants will cover 80% of the salary of retained workers up to the total of £2,500 a month.

Business Rates

Twelve months business rates holiday for retail, hospitality, leisure and financial services. Applied with immediate effect.

Filing Accounts

Businesses will receive a 3 month extension to file accounts with Companies House to avoid penalties.

10k Grant

Available to businesses currently eligible for small business rates relief or rural rate relief.

25k Grant

Provided to retail, hospitality and leisure businesses with a rateable value of £15,000 – £51,000.


